

# Anointing of the Sick – Feb 10/11

Masses the weekend of **Feb 10/11** will have the Sacrament of the <u>Anointing of the Sick</u>. Through this sacrament, "if it be God's will, the person will be physically healed of illness." Even if physical healing does not occur, the "primary effect is that the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age."

St. Bernadette, the patroness of our parish and of illness, suffered from physical illness throughout her short life. She was blessed to help others heal through the intervention of the Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Lourdes.

## Fasting and Abstinence During Lent

For Catholics, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence from meat. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat (land animals). All Catholics, ages 18-59, are to participate in fasting. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. For health reasons, the infirm, ill, pregnant or nursing mothers are exempt.

Other Lenten disciplines include daily prayer, fasting not only from food, but also from behaviors which detract from our relationship with God, and serving others.
